Specimen 1: Gastric. Four tan fragments 2-4mm.

Microscopic:

Specimen 1: The gastric mucosa shows an active chronic gastritis with increased chronic inflammatory cells and smaller numbers of acute inflammatory cells. Moderate numbers of Helicobacter pylori organisms are identified lining pit and surface epithelium. There is no significant mucosal atrophy and no evidence of intestinal metaplasia, dysplasia or malignancy.
